Season of Lent

Here at Our Savior's we are in the full swing of Lent. Our midweek services have begun, we have been enjoying delicious potluck soup suppers and we have been hearing about the promises of God in the covenants of the Old Testament (on Sundays) and through stories from the book of Acts (on Wednesdays). During worship on the second Sunday in Lent, we even sang perhaps the most overtly Lenten hymn, "O Lord, throughout these forty days". But have you ever done the math and wondered how we get 40 days when there are 46 days between Ash Wednesday and Easter? We get 40 because we don't count the Sundays in Lent.

Sundays do not count because each and every Sunday is a mini-Easter, a feast of celebration for the life, death and resurrection of Jesus. So, historically, people have refrained from fasting or other Lenten practices during the Sundays in Lent. I believe that there is great wisdom in this- maintaining that there is room for celebration even amidst the most serious of times like Lent.

This Lenten season, we have a number of various celebrations we will get to take part in, even during the solemnity of Lent. The first of these celebrations will be on Sunday March 10th. This year's recipient of our Lenten midweek offering, Lutheran Retreats, Camps and Conferences, will be bringing camp to us. They will be doing the children's message, sharing about camp and bringing some farm animals from their Luther Glen Farm.

Saturday, March 16th will be a day full of fun for all ages. At 2:00pm Jana Alayra, a well-known and widely loved children's musician, will be on campus to provide a free concert for our church and school families and our community. After the concert at 4pm, we will be having a spaghetti dinner together with live music provided by Greg Gardner. This dinner will be a great opportunity for intergenerational conversations and relationship building.

Finally, we have the excitement of Holy Week. There will be a Palm Saturday Workday, Palm Sunday Pancake Breakfast, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, two Easter Morning Services and an Easter Egg Hunt. Read on to learn more about these offerings and the opportunities for service, fun and worship here at our Savior's.

What joy we can find and have together during this season of Lent at Our Savior's!

God Spotting for Lent

As I write this, we are entering the season of Lent. As is the tradition in the liturgical church we are called to sacrifice, reflect, and prepare for the tragedy and triumph of Holy Week. This year, once again, instead of “giving up” something for Lent I have decided to embrace the 21st century way of doing things and have taken my Lenten journey to social media. Here’s how it works; each day of Lent (remember Sundays don’t count) I use my iPhone camera and take a picture where I see God, I call it “God Spotting”. I then post those pictures along with a brief explanation to my social media accounts, namely Facebook and Instagram. I encourage the youth to “Like” and “Follow” me and join me in my Lenten journey.

Our newest Communion students will be receiving their first communion on March 28th (Maundy Thursday) and of course the reason and point of our faith, Easter Sunday falls on March 31st!

Is it Stewardship, Fellowship, Social Concerns, Worship & Celebration, Evangelism, or Christian Ed? Does it matter? Using the Nike slogan JUST DO IT

As spring approaches there are several opportunities to gather as a church community and/or carry out our mission of *Inspired to Love, Encouraged to Think and Sent to Serve*. I am coming to appreciate that labeling something as falling in a particular ministry category can be tough.

On March 23, 2024, we will be having a Campus Cleanup event followed by pizza (9:00 am to noon). *Sure, this could be considered a Stewardship event, we will be taking care of our church.* But some of the best times I have had at Our Savior's and at other churches are when I have worked side by side with people I saw on Sundays with a common goal in mind. Sharon Seaborn and I used to do Altar Guild together and we talked about all sorts of things, and it was an opportunity to get to know her just a bit better. The Rutherford's, when they can, are helping with the VITA program. Nicole and I have had great conversations that we would never be able to fit in while passing the peace or after church. *So perhaps Campus Cleanup is a fellowship event.* One of the tasks on the list for March 23rd is the cleaning of the Sanctuary for Easter and putting the Palms up for Palm Sunday. Come and find out why we put Palms in the Sanctuary for that day. *So, is campus cleanup a Christian Ed event?* We have invited students from Concordia to help clean out old music files that are in the chancel closet and we may have some high school students helping because they will get service hours. *So, is campus cleanup an evangelism event?* Let's JUST DO IT! There will be tasks that are light duty, medium duty and tasks that take muscle. But come join us.



Just a status on the **Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA Program)** through March 1, we have served over 70 clients and have had 15+ volunteers on the campus. This number will more than double before all things are said and done. The tax preparers love the setup and multiple clients have commented on the beauty of the campus. We have served folks from the age of 19 to 90 and folks that live in their vehicles or own their own home. I have heard stories that break my heart and seen the joy when folks realize that they are getting a large refund due to the tax credits available. Please continue to pray for this ministry and those that we serve.



March 16th will be a remarkably busy day on the OSLC campus. We have the Men's Breakfast, VITA will be in full swing starting at 9:00 am, and at 2:00 pm, there will be the Jana Alayra concert for our young ones. Then afterwards, we will be having a spaghetti dinner for our congregation and those from the concert that want to attend. **The spaghetti dinner will be a youth fundraiser.** Come out and support our youth. Greg Gardner from our worship team band will be tickling the ivories (keyboard) during the dinner. He will get your toes tapping. *So, March 16th, has several of the ministry area covered (Fellowship, Stewardship, Worship and Celebration, Evangelism, and Christian Ed, at a minimum.)*

The Jana Alayra concert and the Spaghetti Dinner are open to the community, so please grab a flyer and share the information with your friends that have preschoolers or those that like spaghetti. *(That's Evangelism.)*

Last and not least is our Social Concerns emphasis for March. We are trying not to bombard folks with fifty different Social Concerns efforts all at once, so we are being a bit more strategic these days. The Preschool has their annual fundraiser in March. The monies donated go to helping our military families with tuition assistance as a way of saying, "Thank you" for their service. You will be receiving a letter about this activity in your mailbox and Amy has provided more detail elsewhere in the newsletter.

In addition, Pastor chose that the midweek Lenten offerings be given to Lutheran Retreats, Camps and Conferences (LRCC). The most familiar LRCC experience to some of you is when our youth go off to El Camino Pines or for those that have been at OSLC awhile, when kids overtook our campus for LRCC Beach Camp. LRCC also has a "farm camp," Luther Glen Farm. LRCC does an excellent job of providing a fun environment for children to learn about our God, the amazing things he does, and the amazing things that we can do as a child of God. LRCC last year introduced an option to "choose your price" for campers. This is intended to allow those that may not have the financial means to attend camp to have an LRCC experience. This "choose your price" option is only possible if people donate the funds to cover the costs.



While not at LRCC, I will share my Dad's experience and how donations to a camp can have far reaching impact. My Grandma in the 1940's was a single Mom and my Dad lived in Vista with his Uncle for a long time. Through scholarships, my Dad was able to attend a few Salvation Army summer camps. It was there that he learned forestry concepts that led him to his college summer job of doing blister rust control in Yosemite. But more to the point, he was so touched by those summer camps that upon his death, my parent's wishes were for a substantial portion of their trust be given to that specific Camp. This was some 80 years after he attended that camp! So please think about the impact your donation to LRCC might have on a child.

On the fun side of things, Luther Glen Farm will be bringing animals to our campus on March 10th. Children of all ages are invited to come after the service and check it out.

Just a note, we will still be gathering laundry detergent bottles for the orphanage, and we will have our special offering on the first Sunday of the month for ELCA World Hunger. We are also happy to collect your empty egg cartons and take them to FAM, where they will put them to use.

I hope to see you outside of Sunday services in the month of March.
